



FAQs about the Registration Fees



- 1. Q If I transfer the vehicle within the current year, do I owe next year's registration fees?
 - A No. The fees must be paid by the holder on January 1st.
- 2. Q I am a co-owner of a vehicle and fee forms have been issued for each TIN. Do all co-owners have to pay them?
 - A No. The fees are indivisible and it is sufficient for one of the co-owners to pay them. If they are not paid, each is jointly liable for the entire amount.
- 3. Q My license plate number has changed, and I paid the fees before the change. Do I also owe fees on the new number?
 - A No, because the two numbers are related and the payment is valid regardless of which number it was made to.
- 4. Q When are fees not due?
 - A When the vehicle has been immobilised, voluntarily or forcibly, before the start of the fee year.
- 5. Q What are the consequences if registration fees are not paid on time?
 - **A** In addition to the annual registration fees, a fine is also imposed:
 - equivalent to the fees, if the vehicle is a two-wheel/three-wheeled private vehicle or a passenger private vehicle.
 - half of the fees, if the vehicle is a passenger car or truck or bus
 - €30, if the registration fees are less than €30
- 6. Q Why does the message "Incomplete data for fee calculation" appear?
 - A Depending on the type of vehicle, the fees are calculated based on the engine cubic centimeters (cc), emissions (CO2), gross weight and seats. If the calculation basis is not completed, the fees cannot be calculated, and you will need to contact the Regional Transport Service to correct the registration license.
- 7. Q Why does the message "The TIN does not appear as the vehicle owner" appear?
 - A The TIN you have filled in is either incorrect (in which case fill in the correct one) or is listed on the TIN license as different from that of the holder (in which case contact the Regional Transport Service) or is different from the data held by our Service (in which case contact the Tax Office).
 - If any of the above is not true, then you may be entering an incorrect registration number.
